Letting Go for Lent

Grace and peace to you!

Four years ago, the arrival of Lent nearly coincided with the arrival of the Covid-19 pandemic, which changed our world in ways we could not have imagined.

We are living out what Lent is all about: a journey of laying down and letting go so that we can become a new creation through the cross and resurrection of Jesus Christ. We are a church that is always being made new, and for that, I rejoice!



Ministry Sharing Update

The Joint Ministries Council met on January 11, and a final draft of the ministry sharing agreement was forwarded to the SWPA Bishop's Office and the Kiskiminetas Presbytery for their approval. The agreement was adopted at the January 28 congregational meeting by a vote of 31-2. Pastor Jim will begin serving both congregations on Tuesday, March 5.






