From the Pastor's Desk

Year of the Lord's Favor

Happy New Year!

Perhaps I should ask, is it a happy new year? It may be if you are planning a wedding, preparing for the birth of a child, or will be going on a long-awaited vacation. Most of us, though, are likely anxious about what 2024 will bring. War rages on in Gaza and Ukraine. The economy continues to struggle. A contentious presidential election awaits. 2024 will also be a year of major change for our church, as we will vote to share my call with Cross Roads Presbyterian Church.

Change and uncertainty weigh heavily on our souls. But as the Body of Christ, our outlook is shaped by the words of the prophet Isaiah and spoken by Jesus at the beginning of his ministry: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor" (Isaiah 61:1-2a, Luke 4:18-19).

In the light of these promises, we look at the future not with dread but with hopeful expectation. Saving grace is promised to all who are afflicted. But will you respond to this promise with faith?

Our worry and dread is not the result of God's failure to act, but our failure to trust God and obey his word. We do not persist in prayer. We allow ourselves to become distracted by the cares and enjoyments of this world. We try in vain to control what cannot be controlled. We fail to change what is in our power to change. We despair because things are not the way they used to be nor the way they should be.


To have faith is to believe that God will do what God has promised to do. By putting God first, we allow God to shape what our future will be. We allow God to transform us so that we can see God's purposes fulfilled. We trust God to meet our needs so that we can meet the needs of others. We embrace change and grieve our losses in the hope of resurrection. We face each new day with confidence that God's goodness awaits us.

This new year is a gift because God uses time to draw you closer to himself and lead you in the way of salvation. The certainty of God's faithfulness is the one certainty we have, and the only one we need.
